Motion by Penny Wardlaw to accept the additions/corrections of all proposed Region 2 Bylaws as presented with the exception of Article 6, Section 1, Quorum question of changing required numbers for quorum delayed for further work, it was seconded by Annette Wells. Motion passed.



### 2015 Championship Endurance Ride

The 2015 Region 2 Championship ride was again held in conjunction with the Bill Thornburgh Family and Friends endurance ride on October 24th in Inyokern. There were 14 cross entries, 10 purebreds and 4 half Arabians. Of the cross entries, 9 purebreds and all of the half Arabians completed the ride.

This was a high completion rate and good horsemanship contributed to this rate since it was a hot day.

This year's cross-entry award was an embroidered maroon fleece lap blanket. The embroidery was in the corner and read AHA Region 2 Endurance Ride. In addition to the blanket all riders received samples of Platinum Equine products. Cross entry awards are given to everyone who enters regardless of their finishing status. The completion award was a high quality bath towel and everyone seemed to enjoy their awards. The purebred division had enough entries for Top 5 awards in addition to champion and reserve while the half Arabian division was awarded champion and reserve awards. For champion and reserve, riders received engraved plaques and remaining top 5 were given nylon leads. The "Best Condition" horse was awarded a 10 pound bucket of Platinum Performance donated by the company.

Of the \$25 cross entry fee, the ride keeps \$10 and \$15 is sent to Region 2. With 14 riders the income to Region 2 is \$210.

As the year comes to an end it is time to submit record of the mares your stallion has bred this year. Stallion reports are another tool that AHA uses to implement our mission to keep accurate and current records, a responsibility in maintaining the integrity of the breed. A stallion report is also a requirement for the registration of the upcoming foal.

Your stallion report can also be beneficial for you as well. Keep record of all purebred and half-Arabian mares you have bred your stallion to throughout the year, sign the report and submit it to AHA by fax, email or regular mail by December 31st to avoid a late penalty. ## USEF New Vaccination Rule

## USEF Equine Vaccination Rule from the USEF Communications Department

**Lexington, Ky.** - In January, the USEF Board of Directors approved an addition to the rule book, which outlines equine vaccination requirements at licensed competitions. Beginning December 1, 2015, all horses entering the grounds of a Federation-licensed competition must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables.

Due to several high profile Equine Herpes (EHV) outbreaks in recent years that have

involved the neuropathic strain of the virus (equine herpesvirus myeloencephalopathy-EHM), some competitions have placed vaccination requirements on their competitors that go beyond most accepted medical opinions and raise concern that unnecessary requirements can potentially put a horse at risk. The intent of this rule is to ensure that all licensed competitions comply with the vaccination guidelines for Equine Influenza and Equine Herpes (rhinopneumonitis) published by the American Association of Equine Practitioners (AAEP). These guidelines are reviewed by infectious disease experts regularly, and recommend vaccinating competition horses at six-month intervals for both equine influenza (flu) and rhinopneumonitis (EHV-1 and EHV-4). There is not a vaccine that protects against EHM.

Intended to promote proper vaccination protocols, this rule does not anticipate an increased workload for competition management. The flu vaccination information can be added to the documentation already required by most competitions: a horse's health certificate and a negative coggins test.


